Please identify that the following information is accurate/correct on your Academic Record:

1. Your name
2. That you are listed as the correct Year Group
3. Then, ALL STUDENTS complete the first section of the Package Check
4. If you study a vocational certificate course, then you complete that VET Section, as well as
5. The Accredited or Tertiary sections
6. Students studying an Accredited Programme need to answer and check the questions for the Accredited section - ONLY
7. Students studying a Tertiary Programme need to answer and check the questions for the Tertiary section – ONLY
8. Please return your COMPLETED package check sheet AND your Academic Record to your LINC teacher.

Package Checks are completed to ensure that you are not missing classes, points, WEX blocks etc. This is one form of tracking that is undertaken to help support you.

### Absences Email

Please note, an Absences Email will be sent out to your parents/guardians **THIS Wednesday**, outlining any absences you have accrued over Term 2. Please ensure that you speak with your parents/guardians and submit an Absences form, to explain the reasons you were away, within **10 working days** of being absent. If you submit your Absences sheet after the 10 days, you will be required to have your Absences Reasons sheet signed by either a Deputy Principal or the Executive Teacher for College LIFE, with a longer discussion about why you have been so late getting your absences sorted out.

The students of Lake Tuggeranong College are proud to present *SCHOOL PLAY*, a stage production that brings together scenes about school from all your favourite movies and TV shows.

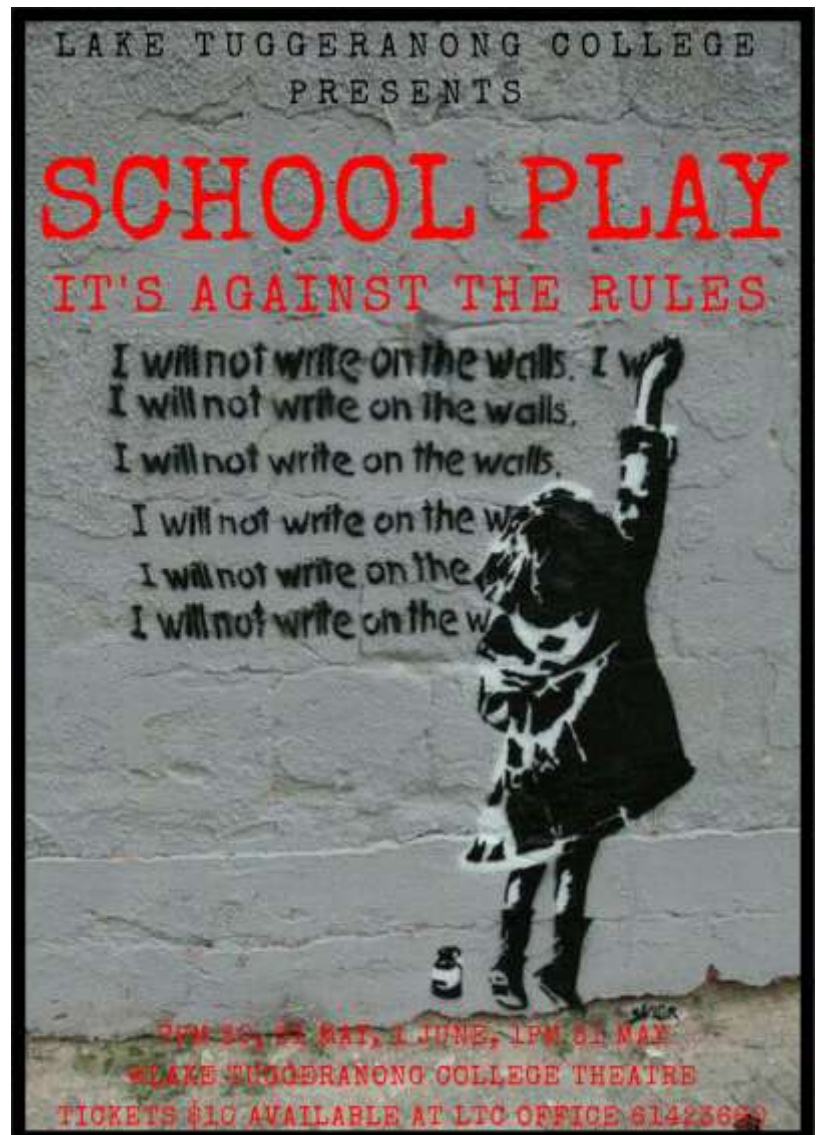
